

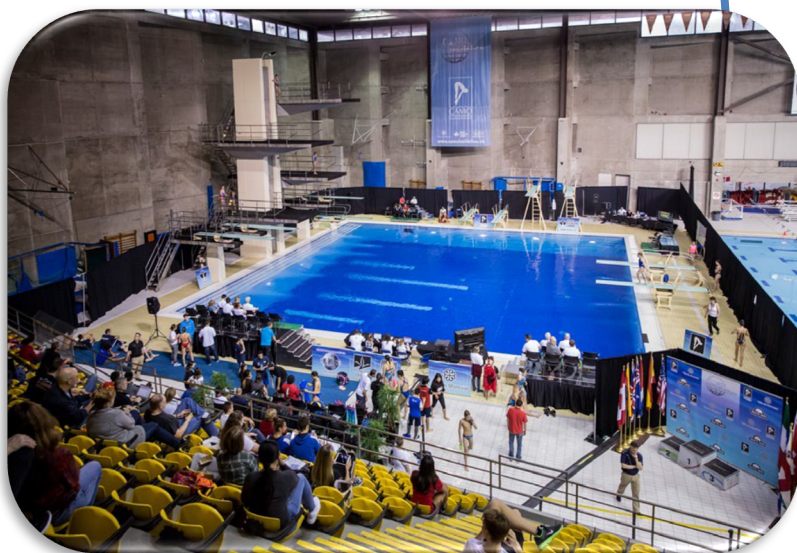

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> GENERAL INFORMATION

25th edition of CAMO invitational International Championship

Since 1996, the CAMO Invitational Championships have welcomed some of the world's top divers to Montréal for an international-calibre competition. Over the years, the event has become a cornerstone of the competitive diving calendar, bringing together elite athletes, coaches, and officials from around the world.

After a two-year hiatus due to the renovation of the pool facilities, we are proud to welcome you back to the Claude-Robillard Sports Complex to celebrate the 25th edition of the CAMO Invitational.

More than just a competition, the CAMO Invitational Championships mark the official start of the competitive season. It is a unique opportunity for athletes to measure themselves against outstanding competition, push their limits, and kick off the season in an exciting atmosphere where performance, passion, and excellence take centre stage.

> **EVENT**

Boys and girls:

- Group C (13 & under) – 1m, 3m and tower
- Group B (14-15) – 1m, 3m, and tower
- Group A (16 - 18) – 1m, 3m, and tower
- Open – 3m and tower
- High Diving (10-12 meters)

> **EQUIPMENT LIST**

- (5) one-meter springboards
- (5) three-meter springboards
- Platforms: 3m, 5m, 7.5m, 10m and 12m
- 1/4m platform
- Platforms all have a skid resistant black “rough-tex” surface
- A duller system is located under every 3m boards and all platforms

> **RULES**

The 2026 World Aquatics rule book as of the 18 of February 2026 shall be the official rules for this event. If there are any inconsistencies between this package and the Rule Book, the Rule Book shall prevail. Any decisions made at this championship by the Jury of Appeal shall be final. The Rule book is also available at www.diving.ca

Age- group determination is the diver’s age as of December 31st, 2026.

Divers can compete in one age-group competition plus the Open events. However, they are not to compete in two different age groups. Group D athletes are invited to compete in the Group C events.

Where one side of the pool is finished before the other, that side will be open for quiet warm-up. The Technical Director reserves the right to close a side for a warm-up if he deems it to be too noisy or disruptive to an event on the other side. Springboards will be open during platform warm up and vice versa.

Events may run up to 1-hour ahead of the scheduled and posted times. We highly suggested coaches and athletes should stay around the pool deck the day they are competing. A revised final schedule will be distributed upon the arrival of the teams.

> RULES FOR CANADIAN ATHLETES

Age Group Events: Only athletes who competed at the Junior Elite National Championships or the Junior Development National Championships are eligible to participate in this competition.

Eligible athletes may compete in all three events. If an athlete does not meet this eligibility requirement, an exemption request may be submitted. To do so, please send an email to the Technical Director, Stéphane Lapointe, at slapointe@camoplungeon.com, explaining the reasons for the request.

Senior Events: All senior events are recognized as qualifying events for the Senior National Championships. Athletes wishing to achieve the Diving Canada senior qualifying standards during the season may use this competition for that purpose.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR TEAM - DIVE LIVE

1. CREATE YOUR TEAM

If your team does not already exist in Dive Live:

- Create a Dive Live account.
- Create your **Team/Club**.
- Enter your team information.

2. ADD YOUR ATHLETES

- Add all athletes who will participate.
- Make sure their information is correct.

3. REGISTER FOR THE CAMO INVITATIONAL

- Find **CAMO Invitational 2026**; <https://diving.scoresandmore.live/MeetShort/7221>
- Select your team.
- Register each athlete in their events.

4. COMPLETE THE DIVING LISTS

- Enter the dive sheet for each athlete.
- Select the dives they will perform.
- Save the dive sheets.
- Dive sheets can be modified directly through the Dive Live app.

All dive sheets must be completed by Wednesday, November 25, 2026, at 12:00 PM.

5. REVIEW & SUBMIT

- Check all athletes, events and dive sheets.
- Complete the payment.
- Submit your registration before the deadline.

REGISTRATION FEES

Registration Fee: \$125.00 USD (taxes included) per diver + \$11.50 USD Dive Live fee = **\$136.50 USD per diver**

Entry Fee: \$75.00 USD (taxes included) per diver, per individual event + \$7.00 USD Dive Live fee = **\$82.00 USD per entry**

All fees are payable through the Dive Live application.

ENTRY DEADLINE

All entries, including payment, received through the Dive Live app no later than **midnight on November 8, 2026.**

Entries received after this deadline will be subject to a **\$30.00 USD late entry fee**, payable through the Dive Live app.

> RESULTS

Participating club and unattached diver/coach will be able to download the full results booklet from www.diving.ca following the event.

All the results will be available on the app DIVE LIVE during and after the events.

> AWARDS AND MEDALS

We request that divers be dressed in full team uniform or club jacket for awards ceremonies and marshalling and towels are not permitted. Appropriate time will be provided between the final event and the award ceremonies.

Awards to be given:

- Top three will receive medals.

> MEETING & HOSPITALITY

On-site Hospitality

The Organizing Committee will provide meals for coaches, judges, athletes, and volunteers throughout the four days of competition.
