

Please send your registration form to Plongeon Québec by email at info@plongeon.gc.ca.

Registration forms must be returned to Plongeon Québec at least two (2) weeks before the first day of competition. Late entries, as indicated by the postmark, email or fax date, will be accepted upon payment of a \$15 penalty fee per business day of being late, up to a maximum of \$150. The hosting committee shall keep the full amount of penalty fees for late entries. If the hosting committee cannot establish that the application was sent late, the relevant team will not be subject to the penalty fee. However, if an athlete must be added to the list after the deadline, the late entry may be added upon payment of a \$5 penalty fee per athlete.

Entry and event fees must be paid to the Plongeon Quebec before the end of the events. Failure to do so will result in a \$20 penalty fee per team payable to the hosting club or organization.

Dive Sheets: To facilitate the hosting committee's work, fully completed dive sheets must be submitted electronically by Tuesday June 4th 2019. at the latest via Rezman.



Rules and regulations: FINA, Diving Canada and Plongeon Québec Handbooks and Rule Books

In accordance with DIVING CANADA RULES.

- The dive sheets, sent electronically, will now be considered signed by the diver and coach. Paper dive sheets will only be used to submit changes.
- When differences are discovered during the competition, the latest sheet sent will be considered to be the official copy.

Please note according to Regulation Q12 from Plongeon Quebec:

- Upon arrival at the competition, each club must have in their possession the SUMMARY sheet of all entries made on Rezman. This sheet will be used to verify in case of error.
- Dive sheets that are not submitted at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the events will only be accepted with a \$25 penalty fee, payable to the hosting club.
- The host committee must post, before the first event of the day, dive lists of each event of that day of competition. Divers must then initial their list if everything is in order. However, if an error is found in a list, the diver must go to the Dive Office to request the changes immediately.
- A diver is allowed to make one or more changes to their dive sheet up to 1 hour prior to either the beginning of the event or the scheduled/announced beginning time of the event, whichever comes first.
