RULE ADDENDUM

The following rules were mistakenly not kept in the rule book. The intention was to keep these requirements in the rules - this Addendum belongs with the Junior Dive Requirements section of the rule book.

ADDENDUM 1

1. JUNIOR DIVE REQUIREMENTS (GROUPS A and B)

1.1. Compulsories (Dives with limited D.D.)

1.1.1. Must be head first however there are exceptions; refer to each age category for clarification.

1.2. Forward Spinning Dives

1.2.1. Refers to somersaulting dives from group 1 and 4

1.3. Back Spinning Dives

1.3.1. Refers to somersaulting dives from group 2, group 3, group 62x and group 63x

1.3.2. All back spinning dives must be performed in a tuck or a pike position

1.4. Twisting Dives

1.4.1. Group 1 and 4 twisting dives must have a minimum of one (1) somersault and one (1) twist

1.4.1.1. The amount of twist must be an even number

1.4.2. Group 2 and 3 twisting dives must have a minimum of one (1) somersault and ½ twist

1.4.2.1. The amount of twist must be an odd number

All corrections and additions will be posted on the new DPC website that will be launched on February 21st next week.

REMINDER FOR SCHEDULE CHANGES AT A COMPETITION

Any schedule change in a competition should be approved by ALL coaches attending the competition, not just the coaches involved in a specific event. Should a coach not be at the pool to be involved in the discussion, an attempt should be made to contact that coach.



REMINDER FOR JUNIOR QUALIFICATION EVENTS AT PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Group D1 & D2, and Group C1 & C2 are all to be held as separate events – they CANNOT be combined.

- D1 goes first, followed by D2 – the break between is only as long as it takes to set the computers up for the D2 event.
- C1 goes first, followed by C2 – the break between is only as long as it takes to set the computers up for the C2 event.

2. Group D and C Final Events.

- Group D and C Finals are not part of the national qualification system so the provinces can make this a “provincial event” with provincial rules and define who can compete in this event. We have received lots of questions on what to do with divers that do not yet have all the dives required for the preliminaries of D1, D2, C1 and C2. You can create an event that uses the framework of the D and C finals but allow the divers to substitute dives where necessary to allow them to compete. **It would be great if all provinces could use the same guidelines for this type of structure.**

CALCULATING TEAM POINTS AT PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

We have had a question regarding how team points at provincial championships could be calculated on the ISS MMS when there are no finals for Group C and D. Please note that:

- **If you ARE NOT running C and D finals at a provincial event, you must specify your C1, C2, D1 and D2 events as FINALS in order to score points.**
- **If you ARE running C and D finals, you must specify your C1, C2, D1 and D2 events as PRELIMS to avoid scoring points.**
