Please join us this year for the annual Polar Bear Classic Diving Invitational, held in memoriam of Vaughan Baird, at the historic Pan Am Pool in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

This year the Polar Bear Classic will also be the trials for the Diving Canada Junior National Team who will be attending a competition in Dresden, Germany in the spring.

The Pan Am Pool was built for the 1967 Pan Am Games and was the first Olympic-sized indoor facility in Canada. Winnipeg had the honour of hosting a second Pan Am Games, and the pool underwent a major facelift in preparation for hosting the 1999 Pan Am Games. Pan Am Pool recently completed more renovations, including construction of a brand-new dryland training room, prior to hosting the 2017 Canada Summer Games this summer, as well as new audio systems and roofing in 2018.

We show our respects for the life of Vaughan L. Baird, in honour of his lifetime commitment to the art and sport of diving. For more information on Vaughan Baird's incredible contribution to diving, please visit www.divemanitoba.ca.

Facilities include two 1-metre springboards, two 3-metre springboards and 3-metre, 5-metre, 7.5-metre and 10-metre platforms, all wide enough for synchronized diving. Dryland includes two trampolines, two dry boards, somersaulting platform, and bouncy floor.

The 2022 Polar Bear Classic will be a very exciting meet, as it will be the first time all national level clubs get together since 2019! It is a sanctioned Diving Canada qualifier for Junior and Senior Nationals.

DPC events follow the rules required for Canadian divers to qualify for Canadian Junior Nationals. This year the competition will also include "Mixed Junior" events on 1m, 3m and platform for divers who do not have the dives required for the DPC events.

EVENTS: 2022 Canadian Junior National Qualifier with sanctioned Age Group events on 1-metre, 3-metre and Platform (Diving Plongeon Canada Rules)

2022 Canadian Senior National Qualifier with sanctioned Open events on 1-metre, 3-metre and Platform (Diving Plongeon Canada / FINA Rules)

Mixed Junior events on 1-metre, 3-metre and platform

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by February 22, 2020

ENTRY FEES: **\$45** registration fee per athlete (includes officials fee)
\$40 per event
Deck Entries are \$50 per diver. Deck entries will be accepted up until one hour prior to the beginning of the event.

RULES:

Diving Plongeon Canada rules will apply to all Age Group events with the exception of the Mixed Junior events. DPC events will use the preliminary rules and will be straight finals.

Age Groups are determined based on the diver's age on December 31st, 2022.

DIVE SHEETS:

Dive sheets must be submitted 24 hours prior to the event.

Changes to dive sheets must be submitted a minimum of 1 hour prior to the event's posted start time.

No new dive sheets will be accepted within one hour of the posted start time of the event.

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the top three in each event.

Ribbons will be presented to 4th – 8th in each event.

HOSPITALITY:***Athletes:***

A boxed lunch program for the 4 days of competition will be available for purchase.

Information, purchase forms and order deadlines will be sent to the registered teams.

Athletes can also bring their own lunches and snacks.

Coaches and Judges:

Lunch will be provided for coaches and judges.

SCHEDULE:

The final event schedule will be provided after the registration deadline.

Covid Protocols may change prior to the event, however at this time we are planning NO open practices on competition days. Instead, there will be a guaranteed 30-minute practice prior to each event. For the trials events in Group A & B, there will be two 30-minute practices prior to each event.

TRAINING:

Training sessions are available starting on Monday. Email entries.revolutiondiving@gmail.com to let us know when your team will arrive (day and time) so that we can organize training times into flights, if need be.

PROVINCIAL MIXED JUNIOR EVENTS

Age: 12-18 years on December 31st of the year of the competition.

Girls' and Boys' Springboard – 1 metre

This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.0, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. FINA D.D. will be used for all dives.

Girls' and Boys' Springboard – 3 metre

This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. FINA D.D. will be used for all dives.

Girls' and Boys' Platform - 5 metre - 7.5 metre – 10 metre

This competition shall comprise seven (7) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. 5 metre, 7.5 metre and 10 metre platforms may be used. FINA D.D. will be used for all dives.
