## **BULLETIN: Proof of Vaccination – 12 Years of Age and Older**

On February 7th, the Province of Manitoba amended the public health orders. Effective February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021, any persons between the ages of 12 and 17 years old must show proof of at least 1 vaccination to enter indoor recreational facilities and participate in indoor sport. If not vaccinated, anybody between the ages of 12 and 17 years old will need to provide negative rapid COVID-19 test result within the previous 72 hours prior to entering a facility and participating in sport. ### **ORDER 13**

13(1) Except for ticketed sporting events under Order 15, indoor sporting and recreational facilities, including dance schools and martial arts studios, must not operate unless the operator:

- (a) ensures that the number of spectators at the facility does not exceed 50% of the usual spectator capacity of the facility; and
- (b) restricts admission of members of the public to the facility to the following:
  - (i) persons who produce proof of vaccination, (ii) persons who produce proof from the Government of Manitoba that there is a medical reason for the person not to receive a vaccine for COVID-19,
  - (iii) persons under 12 years of age,
  - (iv) persons who are at least 12 years of age but who have not yet reached 18 years of age and who produce:
    - (A) proof that they have received one dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine for COVID-19, or
    - (B) proof of a negative rapid COVID-19 test result within the previous 72 hours that is confirmed by a pharmacist or by staff at a nursing station on a First Nation.
