- A Divers born in 2007, 2008 or 2009
- All events will be straight final (no cuts)
- Springboard events will be run independently unless time requires simultaneous.
- Each event will be given a minimum 30 minute warm-up prior to the start of the event.

WESTERN CANADIAN NOVICE DIVING RULES

Updated: February 2025

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL NOVICE AGE GROUPS

ELIGIBILITY

Divers qualified for Diving Plongeon Canada Junior Nationals on any event are not eligible to compete in any Novice events or Novice Nationals.

JUMPS

- The DD for all jumps is 1.0
- Dive numbers for jumps: 100A, 100C, 100B, 200A, 200C, 200B
- · There is no deduction for hands up or hands down on the entry position.

FALL-IN ENTRIES

- The DD for all fall-in entries is 1.0
- 001 and 002 are categorized as "Direction 0", and therefore they do not count as front or back direction.
- Dive numbers for fall-in entries: 001A, 001B, 001C, 002A, 002C, 002B

DIVES

- All Dive numbers entered for Dive #1, Dive #2... must be found on World Aquatics DD sheet.
- A Dive number cannot be performed twice in the same list. For example, 101C and 101B would not be allowed in the same list of dives.
- Jumps (100, 200) and fall-in entries (001, 002) can NOT be used for Dive #1, Dive #2, etc.
 The only exceptions to this rule are clearly outlined below for Group E only.

LIST SUBMISSIONS

- Dive sheets must be submitted according to the timelines laid out by the host club.
- Dives can be changed on the dive sheet up until 15 minutes before the start of the event.
